

Usneoides (Spanish Moss) is native of southern United States, Mexico, Caribbean, Central America, South America, Bermuda, and Bahamas. Spanish moss is a moisture loving air plant.

- Water: Mist your Usneoides daily (morning hours). You can mist every other day, depending on air moisture levels.
   Once per week, shower the usneoides or soak for 5 to 30 minutes. If severely dry, you can soak for several hours. After rinse, dunk, or soak, gently shake off the excess water and let plant hang to
- completely dry with good air circulation.
  Fertilize: Add a little orchids, bromeliad, or tillandsia fertilizer only to filtered water or tap water used to water air plant. No need to add to rain water...nutrients are already present.
- **Light:** Usneoides grows best in bright indirect light. Artificial grow light is a good alternative. Avoid direct, intense sunlight. The heat significantly deplete moisture and dry out the air plant.

**Tips:** Filtered or rain water is best for air plant. Tap water is okay depending on the condition of your local water source. Avoid distilled water. Usneoides require at least 50% air humidity with proper air circulation.
