



Tectorum is an air plant that is native to arid to semi-arid regions of Peru and Ecuador. This plant is drought tolerant and very low maintenance.

- **Water:** Lightly mist at least 3 to 4 times per week (morning hours). This air plant does not need lots of water.

You can briefly shower the tectorum air plant once every 3 to 4 weeks. Do not soak. After shower, immediately shake off excess water and let dry under good air circulation.

- **Fertilize:** Once a month, add a little bromeliad or tillandsia fertilizer only to filtered water or tap water. No need to add to rain water...nutrients are already present.
- **Light:** Tectorum needs a lot of bright light. Artificial grow light is a good alternative. This air plant can thrive in full sunlight due to its thick, fuzzy trichomes.

Tips: Filtered or rain water is best for air plant. Tap water is okay depending on the condition of your local water source. Avoid distilled water. The tectorum require at least 50% air humidity with proper air circulation. Temperature range should be 50° F – 80° F.
